## Welcome!

Time to put our blocks together and make them into a quilt!

## REQUIRED MATERIALS <br> - 1 yard black fabric <br> - $52^{\prime \prime} \times 21^{\prime \prime}$ aqua fabric

- $31 / 4$ yard for backing


## BORDERS <br> Method One:

Sew left and right inner borders FIRST, then trim to be even with the quilt. Repeat for the top and bottom inner borders.

Sew left and right outer borders FIRST, then trim to be even with the quilt. Repeat for top and bottom outer borders.

## Method Two:

Measure the sides of your quilt top.
Write your measurement here: $\qquad$
(Should be 381/2")
Cut (2) inner border strips to this length.
Sew to left and right sides of your quilt.
Measure the top/bottom of your quilt top.

(Should be 401/2")
Cut (2) inner border strips to this length.
Sew to top and bottom of your quilt.


Measure the sides of your quilt top.

Cut (2) outer border strips to this length.
Sew to left and right sides of your quilt.
Measure the top/bottom of your quilt top.

(Should be 471/2")
Cut (2) outer border strips to this length.
Sew to top and bottom of your quilt.

## FINISH THE QUILT

Layer quilt top, batting, and backing. Quilt as desired.
Piece binding strips into one long strip. Fold pieced binding strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press. Line up raw edges of the binding strip with the raw edge of the quilt. Sew binding to the front side of the quilt, starting at any side. Turn the binding over and hand stitch to the back of the quilt.
