

## REQUIRED MATERIALS

- $8^{\prime \prime} \times 8^{\prime \prime}$ each of two greens, two oranges, one rust, one brown
- $9^{\prime \prime} \times 21^{\prime \prime}$ black with orange pumpkins
- $17^{\prime \prime} \times 21^{\prime \prime}$ cream with orange pumpkins
- $14^{\prime \prime} \times 14^{\prime \prime}$ cream
- $5^{\prime \prime} \times 14^{\prime \prime}$ rust stripe
- $5^{\prime \prime} \times 14^{\prime \prime}$ green
- $3 / 8$ yard brown plaid
- various colorful fabrics for appliqué
- $55^{\prime \prime} \times 21^{\prime \prime}$ for backing


## CUT FABRICS

From each of two greens, two oranges, one rust, and one brown, cut:

- (1) 7 " $\times 7$ " square for piecing

From black with orange pumpkins, cut:
-(2) $7^{\prime \prime} \times 7^{\prime \prime}$ squares for piecing
From cream with orange pumpkins, cut:
-(4) $7^{\prime \prime} \times 7^{\prime \prime}$ squares for piecing
From cream, cut:

- (2) $6^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{1 / 2}$ " rectangles for appliqué background

From green, cut:

- (2) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{1 / 2 "}$ strips for outer sashing

From orange stripe, cut:

- (2) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 12^{1 / 2}$ " rectangles for inner sashing

From brown plaid, cut:

- (4) $2^{11 / 2 "} \times$ WOF strips for binding

## PLEASE NOTE

WOF = Width of Fabric
RST = Right Sides Together
All seams are $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ unless otherwise noted.
Please read all instructions carefully before beginning.

## DISAPPEARING 4-PATCH

## FOR THIS BLOCK, PRESS ALL SEAMS OPEN.

STEP 1: Sew (2) cream with orange pumpkins squares, (1) rust square, and (1) green square into a 4 -Patch as shown. STEP 2: Measure and cut 2" from center seams, rotating block $90^{\circ}$ after each cut. STEP 3: Move corner units (outlined in red) one position clockwise.


STEP 4: Refer to this image to verify that all units are arranged properly. STEP 5: Sew units together into rows.
STEP 6: Sew rows together to complete block. Block will measure $12 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$.


Repeat to make a total of (3) Disappearing 4-Patch Blocks, (1) that is cream, green, and rust (Block 1, above), (1) that is black, orange, and orange (Block 2, at right) and (1) that is cream, green, and brown (Block 3, far right).
Set blocks aside for assembly at a later step.

## APPLIQUÉ

Sew (1) rust stripe inner sashing strip to a cream background; press toward inner sashing. Sew (1) green outer sashing strip to the other side; press toward outer sashing. Repeat with second background.


Your diagram has two pages, a Reverse Diagram and an Assembly Diagram. When tracing shapes for fusible appliqué, use the Reverse Diagram.
Gently peel fusible paper from the back of each shapes. Refer to Assembly Diagram to arrange shapes on background fabric.
Appliqué in place using the method and stitch of your choice.


## ASSEMBLE TABLE RUNNER_

Sew blocks together in a row, pressing seams open. Sew one appliqué unit to each side as shown.


## Finish TAble Runner

Layer top, batting, and backing. Quilt as desired.
Piece binding into one long strip. Fold in half lengthwise, wrong sides together, and press. Line up raw edges of the binding with the raw edge of the table runner. Sew binding to the front side of the table runner, starting at any side. Turn the binding over and hand stitch to the back of the table runner.

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
