- ☐ fabric (*Fat Quarters make great options*)
- ☐ Mod Podge®
- ☐ brush
- ☐ scissors

## RECOMMENDED

- ☐ parchment paper (*protects workspace, makes cleanup easy*)



## INSTRUCTIONS

**1.** Cut fabric to size, being sure to allow a ½" - 1" border on all sides even when the book is closed. (See **Diagram 1**)

**2.** Apply a thin layer of Mod Podge®\* to wrong side of fabric with brush.

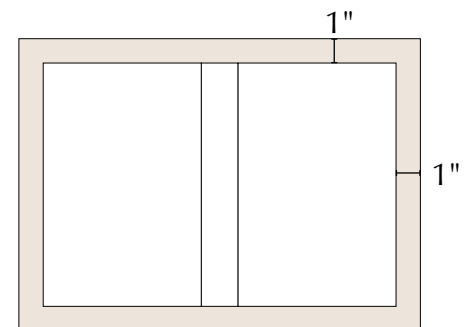
*\*It is best to first pour Mod Podge® into a cup or bowl and dip brush to apply, rather than squeezing Mod Podge® directly onto fabric.*

**3.** Smooth fabric onto cover of book, starting with one cover, then along the spine, then the other cover.

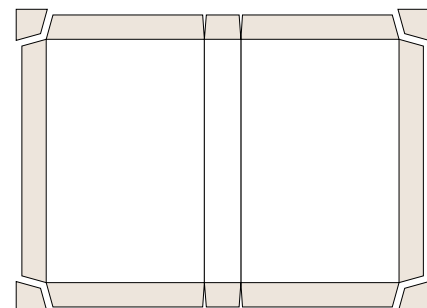
**4.** After outside of book has been covered entirely, cut notches in each corner, and cut slits at the fold points of the spine. (See **Diagram 2**)

**5.** Apply Mod Podge® to fabric borders and fold fabric inwards, tucking spine fabric between pages and cover.

**6.** Allow Mod Podge® to dry for at least 24 hours.
