Finished size: about 7" wide × 12" tall

REQUIRED MATERIALS

- (1) Fat Quarter **each** of (4) **red** fabrics
- (1) Fat Quarter **each** of (4) **white** fabrics
- (1) 12" candy cane wire wreath frame

RECOMMENDED

- Clover Wonder Clips
- Purple Thang
- Olfa 45mm Rotary Cutter

CUT FABRIC

From **each** of (4) **red** fabrics, cut:

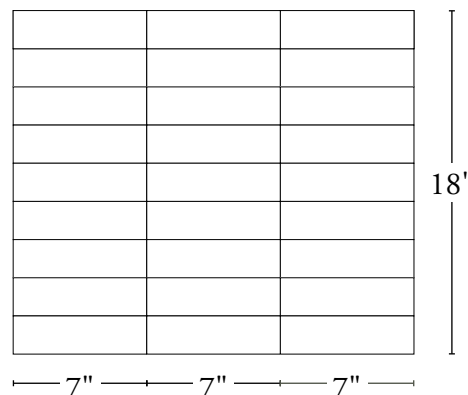
- (3) 7" × 18" strips, subcut to
(27) 7" × 2" rectangles

From **each** of (4) **white** fabrics, cut:

- (3) 7" × 18" strips, subcut to
(27) 7" × 2" rectangles

You will have a total of (216) rectangles: (108) red and (108) white.

For sample project, we used a total of (188) rectangles.



FILL WREATH

Layer (2) red rectangles, wrong sides together.

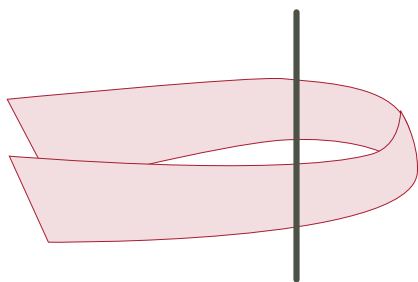


Accordion-fold rectangles lengthwise, which will make a narrow strip that will be easier to loop-and-knot.

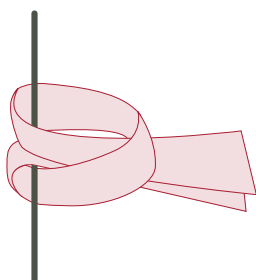


Fold strip in half to form a loop. *We recommend using a Wonder Clip to secure the loop; fold and clip all fabric rectangles, then continue to next step with all fabric loops ready-to-use.*

Beginning in a section near one end of the wreath frame, thread fabric loop behind one wire.

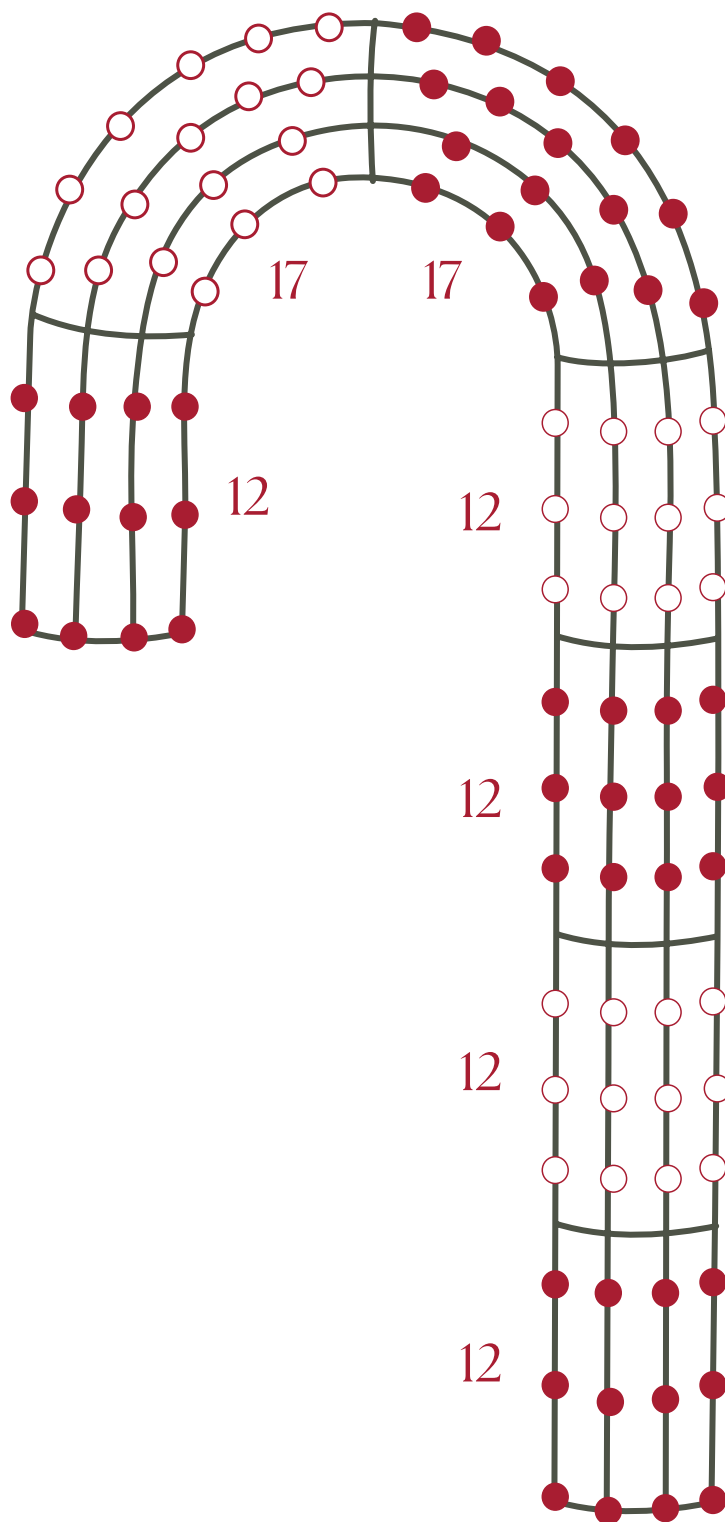


Thread fabric ends through loop.



Pull fabric ends firmly to secure knot.

Referring to diagram (*right*) for placement, continue to add red and white fabric to wreath frame.
