# Flannel Changing Pad

# by MAYWOOD STUDIO



We recommend a shorter stitch length (we used 2.0) for this project.

## Recommended....

- Clover Mini Wonder Clips
- FriXion Clicker Pen 0.7mm
- Clover Point 2 Point Turner

# CUT FABRIC.....

#### From **various colors**, cut:

• (35) 5" × 5" squares

OR (1) pack precut 5" squares for patchwork

For sample project, we used Little Lambies Woolies Flannel

5" Squares by Bonnie Sullivan for Maywood Studio

#### From **backing**, cut:

- (1)  $23\frac{1}{2}$ " ×  $32\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle for **backing**
- (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " × Width of Fabric strip for **ties**

#### From **fusible fleece**, cut:

• (2)  $23\frac{1}{2}$ " ×  $32\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles

# PATCHWORK.....

For this step, use a 1/4" seam allowance. Press all seams open.

Arrange squares as desired in (7) rows of (5) squares each.

Sew squares together into rows, then sew rows together.

Patchwork unit will measure 23" × 32".

Baste 1/8" from outer edge on all four sides.

# TIES\_\_\_\_\_

Refer to diagrams (right).

Trim selvages from ends of **tie** strip. Fold both short ends toward wrong side  $\frac{1}{2}$ " and press.

Fold strip in half lengthwise, wrong sides together, and press.

Open and fold raw edges to meet in the center at the crease, and press.

Fold again so folded edges meet down length, and use Wonder Clips to hold folded edges together.


Top stitch 1/8" to finish all sides and ends of strip.

## Assemble Changing Pad

Fuse (2) layers of fusible fleece to wrong side of patchwork unit. Trim fusible fleece to be even with patchwork.


Place patchwork unit, right side up, on work surface. Fold tie strip in half. Refer to diagram (right) to place tie strip on patchwork unit, aligning center fold of tie strip with raw edge of patchwork. Open strip (so you are only sewing through one layer of tie strip) and baste near raw edge of patchwork.

**IMPORTANT:** Fold tie strip back toward center, and secure loose ends of ties to center of patchwork unit to avoid sewing them into seam.

Layer backing and patchwork, right sides together. If necessary, trim backing to be even with patchwork. Sew around all four sides with a ½" seam allowance, leaving an 8" opening for turning. Backstitch ties to add additional strength in seam allowance.

Trim corners at an angle. Turn right side out, and remove pins so ends of ties are no longer secured to center of patchwork. Push corners out. (We recommend using the Clover Point 2 Point Turner.) Press edges of opening under ½". Press well using steam.

Top stitch around all four sides. (This will close opening.) Quilt as desired.



# FOLD AND ROLL FOR STORAGE.....

Fold changing pad in half so short ends meet. Roll toward side with tie. Wrap tie around rolled changing pad, and secure by tying a simple bow. You're ready to tuck your changing pad into your diaper bag and go!
