







REQUIRED MATERIALS

Items required to complete this block:

-  • (1) 5" x 5" of **purple 1** fabric
-  • (1) 5" x 5" of **purple 2** fabric
-  • (1) 8½" x 13½" of **purple 3** fabric
-  • (1) 5" x 9" of **purple 4** fabric
-  • (1) 7½" x 42" **cream** fabric





CUT FABRICS



From **purple 1** fabric, cut:

- (1) 3⅞" x 3⅞" square
 Cut in half - once - on the diagonal 


From **purple 2** fabric, cut:

- (1) 3⅞" x 3⅞" square
 Cut in half - once - on the diagonal  (you will only use 1)



From **purple 3** fabric, cut:

- (2) 3⅞" x 3⅞" square
 Cut in half - once - on the diagonal 
- (1) 6⅞" x 6⅞" square
 Cut in half - once - on the diagonal  (you will only use 1)

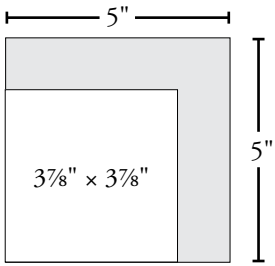
From **purple 4** fabric, cut:

- (2) 3⅞" x 3⅞" square
 Cut in half - once - on the diagonal 

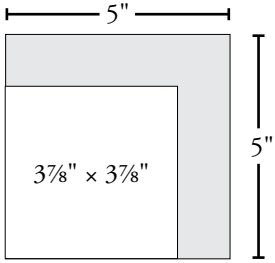
From **cream** fabric, cut:

- (1) 6⅞" x 6⅞" square
 Cut in half - once - on the diagonal  (you will only use 1)
- (2) 6½" x 3½" rectangles
- (3) 3⅞" x 3⅞" squares
 Cut in half - once - on the diagonal  (you will only use 5)

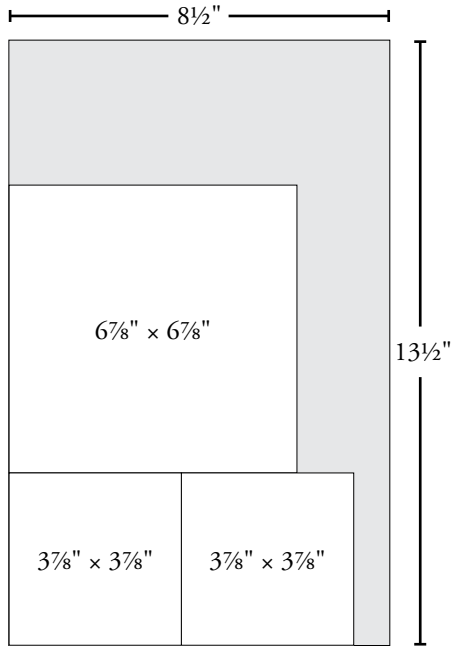

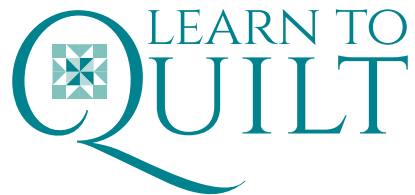


Refer to the video to assemble the block.
