REQUIRED MATERIALS

1 Jelly Roll for **spinning rails**
2¼ yards for **setting triangles** and **binding**
2 yards for **outer border**
3¾ yards for **backing**
Spinning Possibilities Ruler

Olfa Spinning Rotary Mat 17" × 17"
12½" × 12½" OmniGrip® Square Ruler
6½" × 12½" Creative Grids® Ruler

SETTING TRIANGLES

(40) 7¼" × 7¼" squares

Cut in half once on the diagonal



In the video, Jennifer cut her corner triangles to 7" squares. If you'd like a little wiggle room, you can cut them to 7¼" squares. Either measurement will work for this quilt.

OUTER BORDER

(4) 5½" × LOF (Length of Fabric) strips

BINDING

(7) 2½" × WOF (Width of Fabric) strips
