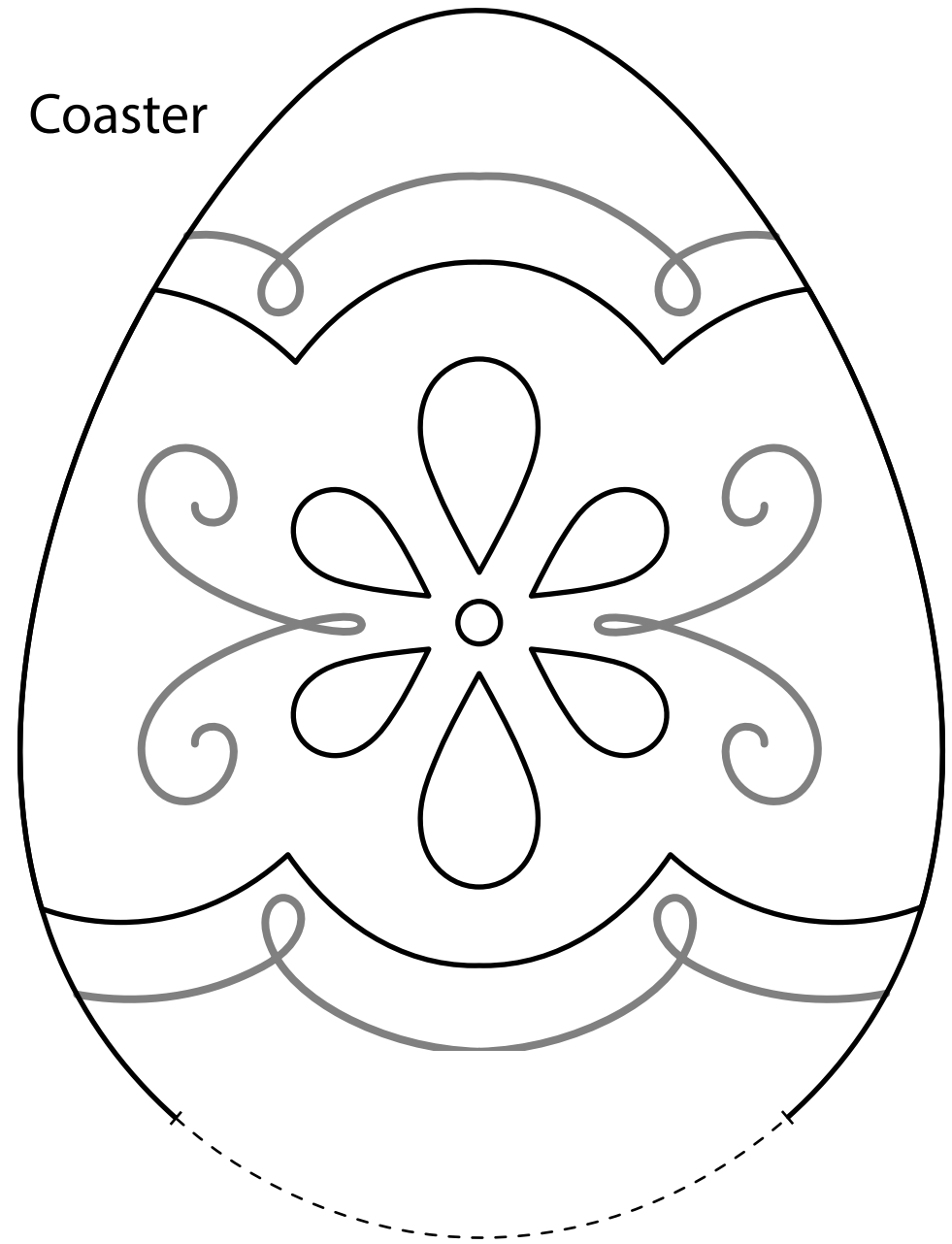

BASIC INSTRUCTIONS

1. Align arrows as instructed on diagram and tape pages together.
2. Roughly cut around shapes.
3. Layer two fabrics, right sides together (RST).
4. Pin shapes to fabric.
5. Cut fabric on drawn line, referring to diagram (*page 4*) for placement.
6. Trace appliqué shapes on fusible web, and fuse webbing to wrong side of accent fabric.
7. Cut appliqué shapes on drawn line. Remove paper backing, and fuse to egg shape.
8. Using a fine-tipped pen, such as a Micron pen, trace stitching lines.
9. Place the layered shapes, RST, on top of a piece of fusible fleece, and iron in place.
10. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " around entire shape, leaving opening for turning.
11. Trim batting and clip curves.
12. Turn right side out and push rounded edges out.
13. Press and top stitch around the entire shape.
14. Stitch embroidery lines using a complementary thread.
15. Set a festive table and gather the family for dinner!

Makes 4 Placemats and 8 Coasters

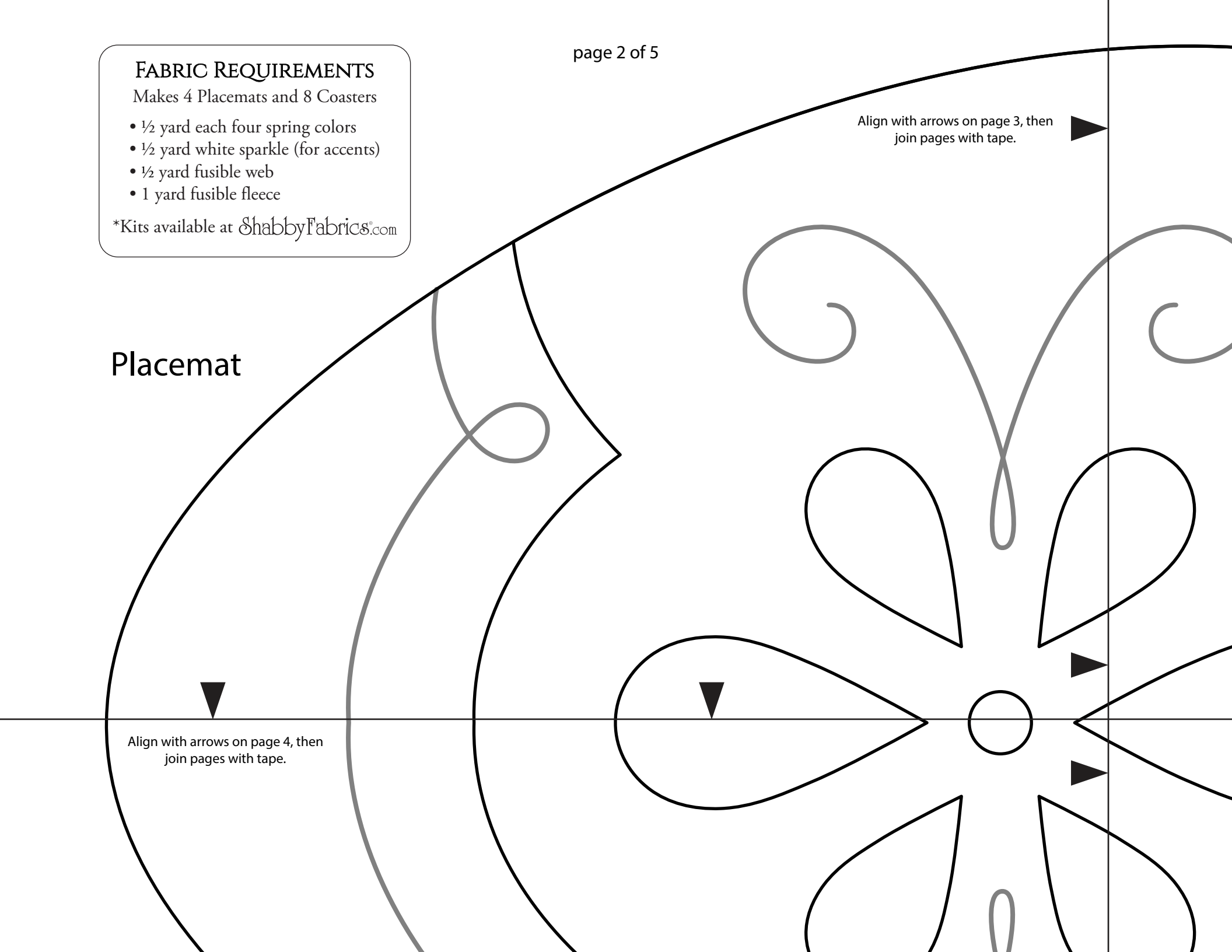
- ½ yard each four spring colors
- ½ yard white sparkle (for accents)
- ½ yard fusible web
- 1 yard fusible fleece

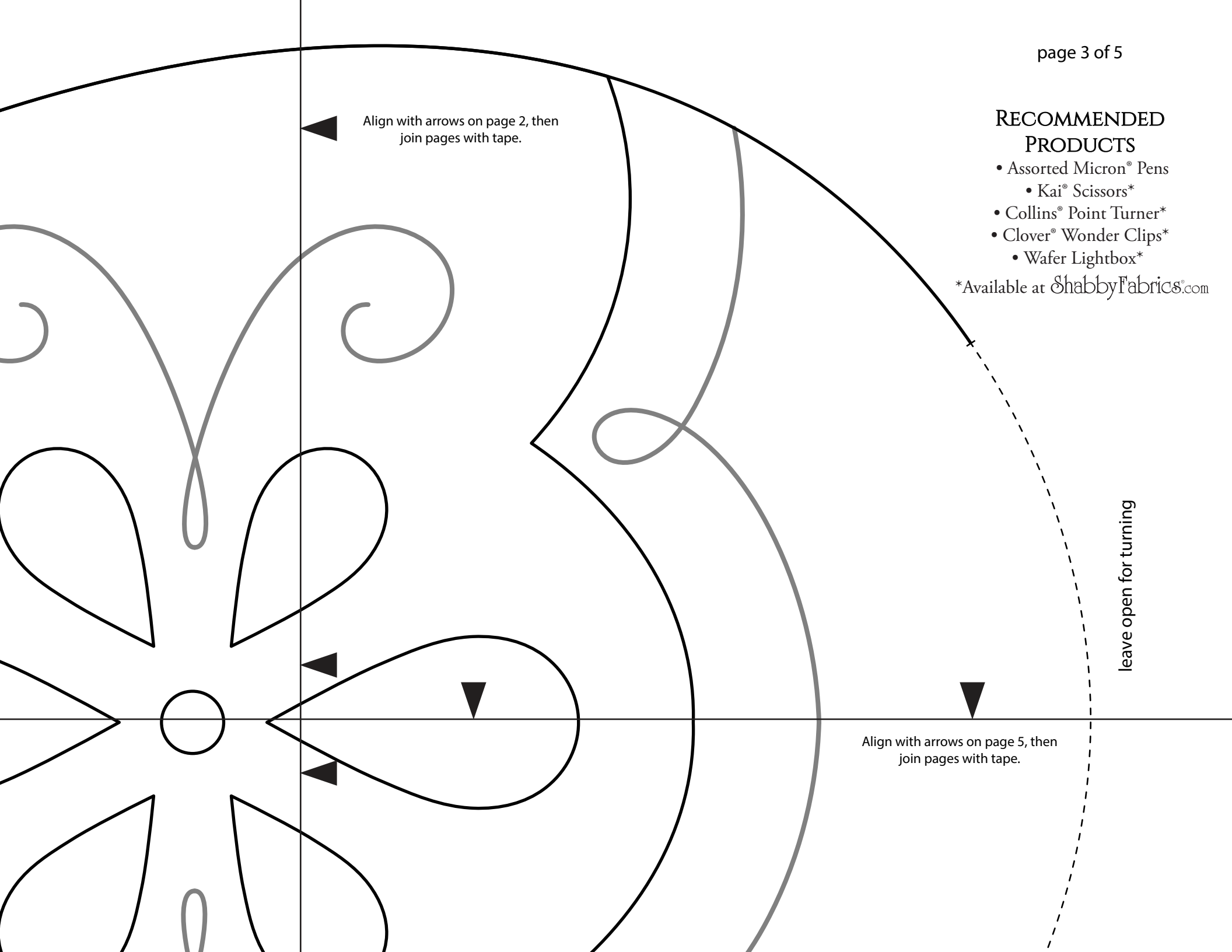

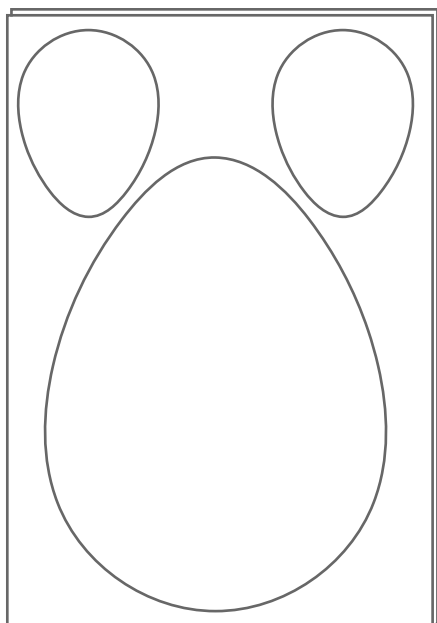

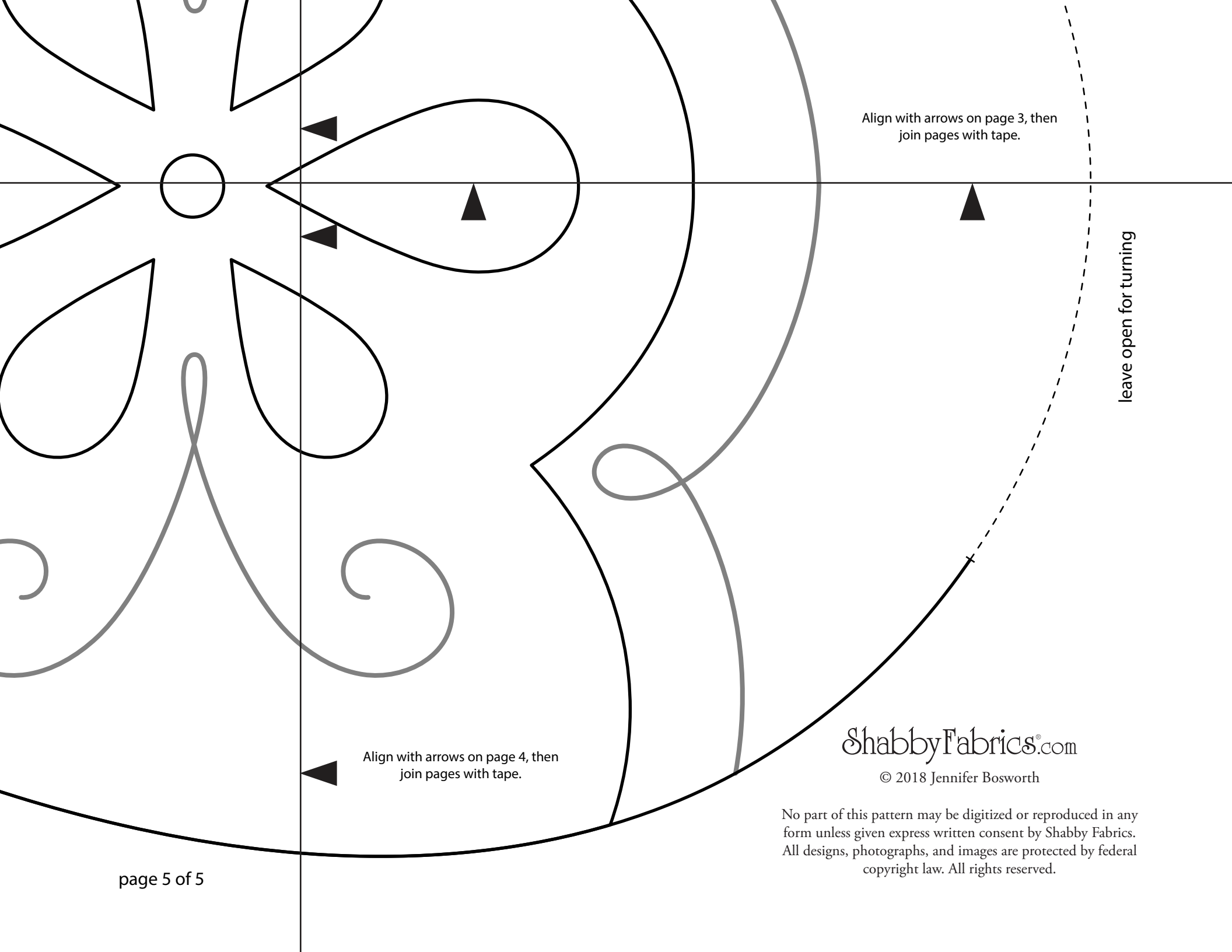
Align with arrows on page 5, then
