FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Makes 4 Placemats and 8 Coasters

- 1½ yard white for placemats
- FQ **each** of 3 reds for stripe appliqué
- FQ blue for star field appliqué
- 14" × WOF red for coasters
- 14" × WOF blue for coasters
- FQ white for star appliqué
- 2 yards fusible web
- 1 yard fusible fleece

Align arrows on page 1 with arrows on
page 2, then join pages with tape.

Align arrows on page 1 with arrows on page 3, then join pages with tape.

Placemat

Align arrows on page 1 with arrows on page 2, then join pages with tape.

Align arrows on page 2 with arrows on page 4, then join pages with tape.

leave open for turning

BASIC INSTRUCTIONS

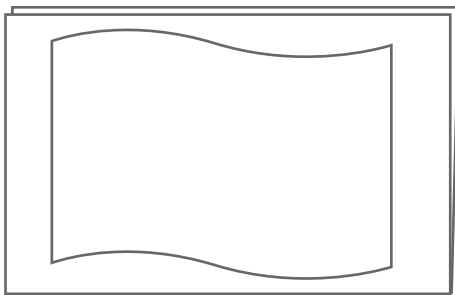
1. Align arrows on diagram page 1 with arrows on diagram page 2, and tape pages together.
2. Roughly cut around flag shape.
3. Fold white fabric, right sides together (RST).
4. Pin flag shape to fabric.
5. Cut fabric out on drawn line.
6. Remove paper backing from appliqué shapes.
7. Fuse appliqué shapes to flag background.
8. Place front and back flag RST, on top of a piece of fusible fleece, and iron in place.
9. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " around entire flag, leaving opening for turning.
10. Trim fleece and clip curves.
11. Turn right side out and push corners out.
12. Press and top stitch around the entire flag. This will close the opening.
13. Stitch appliqué shapes using a complementary thread.

Align arrows on page 1 with arrows on page 3, then join pages with tape.



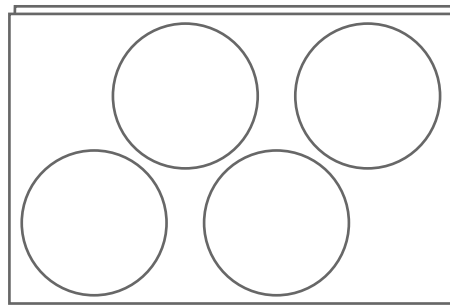

Fold white fabric in half, right sides together.
Your folded fabric will measure $13\frac{1}{2}'' \times 21\frac{1}{2}''$.
Each white fabric will yield 1 placemat.



Repeat for a total of (4) placemats.

Fold red fabric in half, right sides together.
Your folded fabric will measure $14'' \times 21\frac{1}{2}''$.
Arrange shapes on folded fabric as pictured
in this diagram to make (4) red coasters.



Repeat with blue fabric to make (4)
blue coasters.



Align arrows on page 2 with arrows on page 4, then join pages with tape.

leave open

BASIC INSTRUCTIONS FOR COASTERS

1. Fold coaster fabric, right sides together (RST).
2. Pin coaster circle to fabric.
3. Cut fabric out on drawn line.
4. Cut one circle from fusible fleece.
5. Fuse one coaster circle to fusible fleece.
6. Layer one coaster circle, RST, on top of one fleece-backed circle.
7. Sew around entire circle. Do not leave an opening.
8. Grasp coaster in the center and pull apart. Carefully cut a small X in the single layer of fabric in center just large enough to turn coaster right side out.
9. Clip curves.
10. Turn right side out through opening, and press.
11. Remove paper backing from appliqué star.
12. Fuse appliqué star over X to cover opening.
13. Top stitch around entire coaster, and stitch appliqué star using a complementary thread.

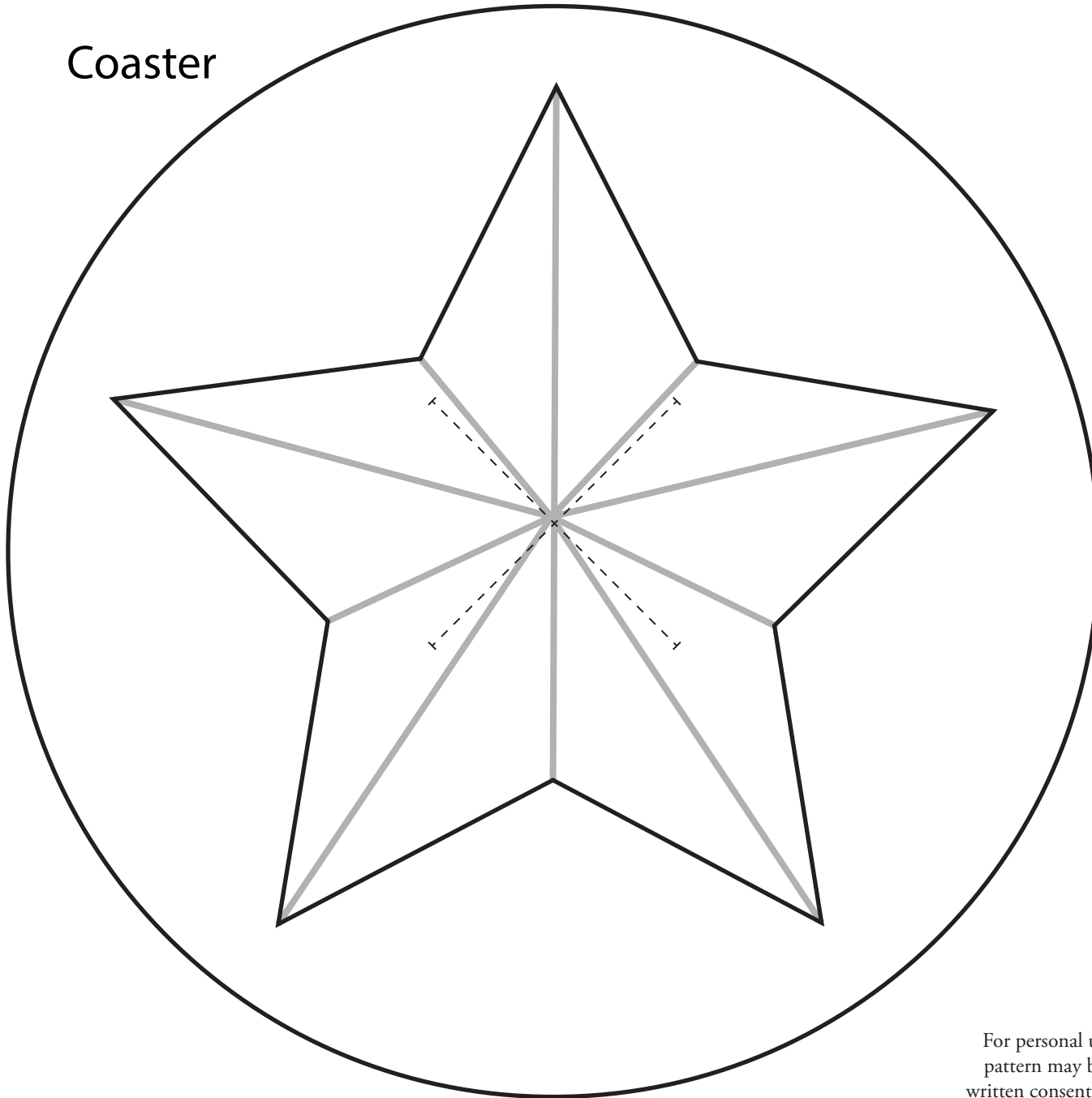
