Finished Size: 55½" × 73½"

REQUIRED MATERIALS

Multi-Size Peaky and Spike Templates

from Marti Michell*

1½ yard **cream fabric**

4¾ yards **various blue fabrics**

⅓ yard for **inner borders**

1⅛ yard for **pieced outer borders**
OR 2 yards for **continuous outer borders**

½ yard for **binding**

To make the quilt as seen in the video, you will need:

- (18) **54° 40' or Fight** blocks
- (17) **Snowball Variation** blocks
- (6) 1½" × WOF strips for **inner border**

First determine whether you prefer **pieced outer borders or **continuous outer borders**.**

- For **pieced outer borders**, cut (7) 4½" × WOF
- For **continuous outer borders**, cut (4) 4½" × 68"
- (7) 2½" × WOF strips for **binding**

Labels indicate finished measurements

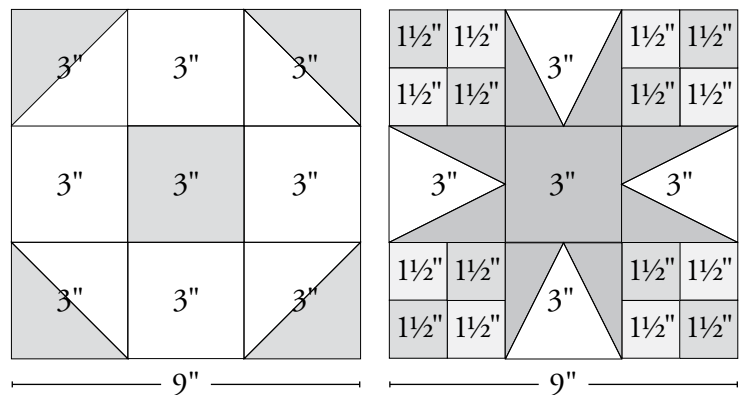
RECOMMENDED MATERIALS

Olfa® Spinning Rotary Mat 12" × 12"*

Olfa® Rotary Cutter*

Star Singles 3" Half Square Triangle Paper*

PLEASE NOTE: In the video, at about 3:24,
we say to use a 3" strip.

The strip should be cut to 3½".

Both strips that will be used to cut Peaky and Spike shapes
should be cut to 3½"
