2¼ yards for setting triangles and binding
2 yards for outer border
3¾ yards for backing

SETTING TRIANGLES

(40) $7\frac{1}{4}$ " × $7\frac{1}{4}$ " squares Cut in half once on the diagonal



In the video, Jennifer cut her corner triangles to 7" squares. If you'd like a little wiggle room, you can cut them to 7½" squares. Either measurement will work for this quilt.

Outer Border

(4) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " × LOF (Length of Fabric) strips

BINDING

(7) 2½" × WOF (Width of Fabric) strips
