(40) $71 / 4$ " $\times 7 \frac{1}{4}$ " squares

Cut in half once on the diagonal


In the video, Jennifer cut her corner triangles
to 7 " squares. If you'd like a little wiggle
room, you can cut them to $71 / /^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
Either measurement will work for this quilt.

## Outer Border

(4) $5 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ LOF (Length of Fabric) strips

## Binding

(7) $21 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF (Width of Fabric) strips

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
