## PIECED HEART BLOCK

## CUT FABRIC\_\_\_\_\_

From **cream**, cut:

- (2)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " ×  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares
- $(4) 1" \times 1"$  squares

From **pink**, cut:

• (2)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " ×  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles


## HEART BLOCKS\_\_\_\_\_

**STEP 1:** On the back of (2) cream 1"× 1" squares, draw a line diagonally from corner to corner. Place squares in upper corners of a pink 2½" × 4½" rectangle, right sides together, noting the orientation of the diagonal.


**STEP 2:** Sew on the drawn lines, and trim seam allowances to ¼". Press to the outside.

**STEP 3:** On the back of one cream dot 2½" × 2½" square draw a line diagonally from corner to corner. Place square on the bottom of the pink rectangle, RST, noting the orientation of the diagonal.


**STEP 4:** Sew on the drawn line, and trim seam allowance to ¼". Press to the outside. This is the left unit of the Heart Block.








**STEP 5:** Repeat Steps 1-4 for (1) additional rectangle of the same pink fabric, noting the orientation of the diagonal. This is the right unit of Heart Block.

**STEP 6:** Join left unit and right unit of Heart Block. Press seam open.

Heart Block should measure 4½" × 4½".
