

## WELCOME BACK!

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Let's get started! This is the Log Cabin Block, made from your beautiful blue fabrics.

## REQUIRED MATERIALS

Items required to complete this block:

- (1) white
- (6) blues
- Standard Sewing Supplies


## Prepare Fabric

Press with sizing on wrong side of fabric.

## CUT FABRIC

Focus on accuracy. It's time to show your skills!
From white, cut:

- (1) $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ square

From light blue dot, cut:

- (1) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{1 / 2 "}$ strip

Subcut to $2^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle and $2^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle
From medium blue solid, cut:

- (1) $5^{\prime \prime} \times 14^{\prime \prime}$ strip

Subcut to $2^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle and $2^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{1 / 2}$ " rectangle
From light blue solid, cut:

- (1) 2 " $\times 21$ " strip

Subcut to 2 " $\times 6^{1 / 2 "}$ rectangle and $2^{\prime \prime} \times 8^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle
From navy with blue dot, cut:

- (1) 2 " $\times 21^{\prime \prime}$ strip

Subcut to $2 " \times 8^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle and $2 " \times 9^{1 / 2 "}$ rectangle
From bright blue dot, cut:

- (1) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 21^{\prime \prime}$ strip

Subcut to 2 " $\times 9^{1 ⁄ 2}$ " rectangle and $2 " \times 11$ " rectangle
From dark blue solid, cut:

- (2) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 21^{\prime \prime}$ strips

Subcut to 2 " $\times 11^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle and $2 " \times 12^{1 / 2}$ " rectangle

## LET'S SEW THE BLOCK!

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To begin, sew $31 / 2$ light blue dot rectangle to white square.
Press seams away from center square.
Continue around the square, making sure each log fits perfectly. If not, stop and see why!

- Are your cuts accurate?
- Do you need to adjust your seam allowance?

Refer to diagram frequently for placement.
After the first round, block should measure $61 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 22^{\prime \prime}$.
Unsure of where to start? Add to the side with the double seam.
After the second round, block should measure $91^{1 / 2} \times 9^{1 / 2}$ ".
After the final round, block should measure $12 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{1 / 2}$ ".
