## WELCOME BACK!

Let's get started! This is the Log Cabin Block, made from your beautiful blue fabrics.

# REQUIRED MATERIALS \_\_\_\_

Items required to complete this block:

- (1) **white**
- (6) **blues**
- Standard Sewing Supplies

## Prepare Fabric \_\_\_\_\_

Press with sizing on wrong side of fabric.

## CUT FABRIC \_\_\_\_\_

Focus on accuracy. It's time to show your skills!

#### From **white**, cut:

• (1)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " ×  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square

#### From **light blue dot**, cut:

• (1)  $2" \times 10\frac{1}{2}"$  strip Subcut to  $2" \times 3\frac{1}{2}"$  rectangle and  $2" \times 5"$  rectangle

#### From **medium blue solid**, cut:

• (1)  $5" \times 14"$  strip Subcut to  $2" \times 5"$  rectangle and  $2" \times 6\frac{1}{2}"$  rectangle

## From **light blue solid**, cut:

• (1)  $2" \times 21"$  strip Subcut to  $2" \times 6\frac{1}{2}"$  rectangle and  $2" \times 8"$  rectangle

#### From **navy with blue dot**, cut:

• (1) 2" × 21" strip Subcut to 2" × 8" rectangle and 2" × 9½" rectangle

## From **bright blue dot**, cut:

• (1) 2" × 21" strip Subcut to 2" ×  $9\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle and 2" × 11" rectangle

#### From dark blue solid, cut:

• (2) 2" × 21" strips Subcut to 2" × 11" rectangle and 2" × 12½" rectangle





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

# LET'S SEW THE BLOCK!

To begin, sew 3½" light blue dot rectangle to white square.

Press seams away from center square.

Continue around the square, making sure each log fits perfectly. If not, stop and see why!

- Are your cuts accurate?
- Do you need to adjust your seam allowance?

Refer to diagram frequently for placement.

After the first round, block should measure  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " ×  $6\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Unsure of where to start? Add to the side with the double seam.

After the second round, block should measure  $9\frac{1}{2}$ " ×  $9\frac{1}{2}$ ".

After the final round, block should measure  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " ×  $12\frac{1}{2}$ ".
