PINWHEEL BLOCK

CUT FABRIC_____

From **blue**, cut:

• (2) 3" × 3" squares

From **brown**, cut:

• (2) $3'' \times 3''$ rectangles



STEP 1: On the back of (1) blue square, draw a line diagonally from corner to corner.

STEP 2: Place blue square on top of (1) brown square, right sides together.

STEP 3: Sew 1/4" from each side of the drawn line.

STEP 4: Cut on the drawn line.

STEP 5: Open and press seam toward blue. You will now have two Half Square Triangles (HST).

Repeat to make a total of (4) HST.



Lay out HST as shown. Sew together into rows, pressing seams open. Sew rows together into a block, pressing seam open.

IMPORTANT: Trim pinwheel block to $4\frac{1}{2}$ " × $4\frac{1}{2}$ ".
