All seam allowances are 1/4" RST = Right Sides Together

CUT FABRICS_____

From **green**, cut:


• (8) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " × $1\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

From purple, cut:

• (4) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " × $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

Pansy Block_____

STEP 1: On the back of each 1½" × 1½" green square, draw a line diagonally from corner to corner. **STEP 2:** Place a green square in the upper left-hand corner of a purple square, RST, noting the orientation of the diagonal. **STEP 3:** Sew on the drawn line, and trim seam allowance ¼". Press toward the outside. **STEP 4:** Place a green square in the upper right-hand corner of a purple square, RST, noting the direction of the diagonal. **STEP 5:** Sew on the drawn line, and trim seam allowance ¼". Press toward the outside. **STEP 6:** Repeat these steps for (3) additional squares of the same purple fabric. **STEP 7:** Arrange four units so the purple squares form a flower. **STEP 8:** Sew the units in each row together; press seams open. Sew the top row to the bottom row; press seams open. Pansy Block will measure 4½" × 4½".




