## Zivzag Start

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning. All instructions include a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

## 1. Cut Fabrics:

Fabric A (5" Karat Crystals - Liberty Lane):
Reserve (16) 5" squares for Half Square Triangles
Trim (16) $5^{\prime \prime}$ squares to $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square
Fabric B (5" Karat Gems - Cookie Dough):
Reserve (16) 5" squares for Half Square Triangles
Trim (16) 5" squares to $4 ½$ " square
Fabric C (blue with stars):
Cut (5) $21 / 2$ x WOF strips for binding
Fabric D (light blue with words):
$72^{\prime \prime} \times 21^{\prime \prime}$ for backing

## 2. Basic Instructions:

1. Make Half Square Triangles (HST):

Step 1: Place (1) Fabric B square on top of (1) Fabric A square, right sides together.
Step 2: Draw a line from one corner diagonally to the opposite corner.
Step 3: Sew $1 / 4$ " on either side of the drawn line.
Step 4: Cut on the drawn line.
Step 5: Open and press seam toward Fabric A. You will now have (2) Half Square Triangles (HST).

Make a total of (32) HST units. Trim each HST unit to 41/2" $\times 4 \frac{1}{2}$ ".
2. Refer to Table Runner Layout (right) for arrangement and placement HST units and Fabric A and B 41⁄2" squares.
3. Arrange Fabric $\mathbf{A}$ and $\mathbf{B}$ squares and HST units in 4 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together.
4. The table runner measures approximately $16 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 641 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (unfinished). Make backing (Fabric D) approximately 4-6" larger than the top.
5. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (Fabric C).
