

FLYING GEESE BLOCK

PLEASE NOTE

All seam allowances are $\frac{1}{4}$ " RST - Right Sides Together

CUT FABRIC

From **cream**, cut:

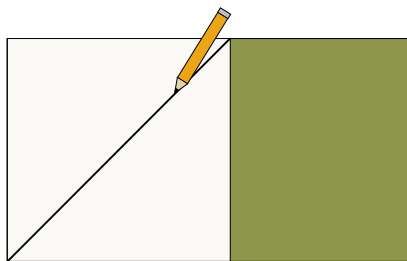
- (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " \times $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

From **color**, cut:

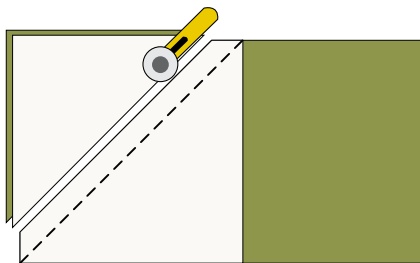
- (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " \times $2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle

FLYING GEESE BLOCK

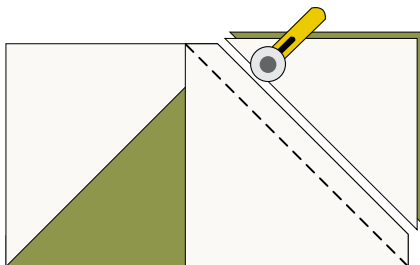
STEP 1: On the back of each cream square, draw a line diagonally from corner to corner. Place a cream square, RST, on the left side of color rectangle, noting the orientation of the diagonal line.



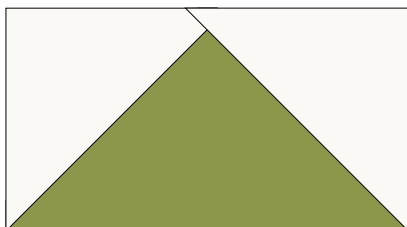
STEP 2: Sew on the drawn line, and trim seam allowance to $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Press to the outside.



STEP 3: Place a second cream square, RST, on the right side of rectangle, noting the orientation of the diagonal line. Sew on the drawn line, and trim seam allowance to $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Press to the outside.



Flying Geese Block will measure $4\frac{1}{2}$ " \times $2\frac{1}{2}$ ".
