PIECED LEAF BLOCK

NOTE

All seam allowances are ¼" HST = Half Square Triangle RST = Right Sides Together

CUT FABRICS

From tan, cut:

- (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " × $1\frac{1}{2}$ " square
- (3) 1\%" × 1\%" squares

From gold, cut:

• (3) 17/8" × 17/8" squares

From **yellow**, cut:

• (1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " × $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square





STEP 1: On the back of (1) tan 17/8" × 17/8" square, draw a line diagonally from corner to corner. **STEP 2:** Layer tan 17/8" × 17/8" square on top of gold square, RST, making sure to line up the edges. **STEP 3:** Shorten your stitch length and sew 1/4" on both sides of the drawn line. **STEP 4:** Cut on the drawn line. Press toward color. **STEP 5:** You will now have two HSTs, which should each measure 11/2" × 11/2" square.














STEP 6: Using (2) additional 178" × 178" tan squares, and the (2) remaining gold squares, repeat Steps 1-5 to make four more HST. You will now have six HST. Join them into two rows of three, orienting diagonals as shown, pressing seams open.



STEP 7: Sew (1) $\tan 1\frac{1}{2}$ " × $1\frac{1}{2}$ " square to the right end of the top row as shown, pressing toward tan square.





STEP 8: Join row of three HST to the right side of yellow square, pressing toward colored square.

STEP 9: Join top row to complete the block, pressing toward colored square.



Leaf Block will measure $4\frac{1}{2}$ " × $4\frac{1}{2}$ ".
