embroidery hoop (any size; we used 12")
 fabric (Fat Quarters make great options)
 scissors

 (we recommend Karen Kay Buckley Perfect Scissors)

 hot glue gun / clear glue sticks

RECOMMENDED

parchment paper (protects workspace, makes cleanup easy)



INSTRUCTIONS

- **1.** Leaving a 1" 2" border around hoop, cut (2) pieces of fabric to size.
- 2. Fold (1) piece of fabric in half with wrong sides together.
- 3. Loosen hoop screw to separate inner hoop and outer hoop.
- **4.** Place unfolded fabric over inner hoop, then layer folded fabric on top, with fold aligned toward top. (**See Diagram 1**)
- 5. Place outer hoop on top of fabric.
- 6. Tighten screw to secure hoops together.
- 7. Pull fabric taut.
- 8. Flip hoop over. Cut excess fabric around hoop, leaving a 1" border.
- **9.** Apply hot glue to hoop, then fold fabric inward. Hold until glue has set.



get creative!

- Using hot glue, apply jute string or ribbon in a zig zag formation to create a memo board
- Create a unique pocket by layering folded pocket diagonally.
- Create two pockets by layering two folded pieces on top of one another.
