## Cooling Neck Wrap

Finishes to approximately 2" × 391/2"

PLEASE NOTE	
All seams are 1/4"	WOF = Width of Fabric



## REOUIRED MATERIALS.....

- 4½" × WOF fabric (approximately 40-44" long)
- about 1½ teaspoons Miracle-Gro® Water Storing Crystals

## RECOMMENDED PRODUCTS

- Turn-it-All Tube Turners 3 sizes
- Clover Chaco Liner Pen Style OR Bohin Mechanical Pencil
  9mm White

## Instructions.....

**STEP 1:** Fold and press **one** short end ½" toward wrong side of fabric.

STEP 2: Fold fabric lengthwise, right sides together, and pin well.

STEP 3: Sew the short end that was not folded.


**STEP 4:** Sew the long side, backstitching at beginning and end of seam.



**STEP 5:** Use a Tube Turner to turn tube right side out. Press.

**STEP 6:** Fold tube in half to find the center, and mark with a temporary marking pen (such as a FriXion pen).

**STEP 7:** Measure from center point in both directions, marking (3) 3" sections in each direction with a temporary marking pen.



**STEP 8:** Shorten your stitch length. Start with the line <u>nearest the closed end</u> (indicated by <u>red</u> arrow), and sew on the marked line, backstitching at beginning and end of seam. *This seam must be secure to prevent crystals from escaping the section*.



**STEP 9:** Use the large, white tube in the Tube Turner set; insert tool in fabric tube, gathering fabric until end of tube is positioned in Section 1. Carefully pour ½ teaspoon of water crystals through tube into Section 1. Be sure all crystals stay in Section 1 as you sew along the second line, backstitching at beginning and end of seam.

STEP 10: Continue sewing additional sections, adding 1/4 teaspoon water crystals to each section, until all (6) sections are filled.

**STEP 11:** Close open end by topstitching with an 1/8" seam.

Soak tube in cold water to hydrate water crystals, and enjoy your finished Cooling Neck Wrap!
