# WOVEN FABRIC BASKET

Finishes to approximately 4" × 4" × 2½"





**Please read through all instructions before beginning.** WOF = Width of Fabric

## REQUIRED....

- ½ yard tan gingham fabric
- 5/8 yard Pellon 950F ShirTailor Fusible Interfacing
- Heat N Bond Ultra Hold (17" × 1 yd package)

### RECOMMENDED.....

- Clover Wonder Clips
- Schmetz Super Nonstick Needles Size 100/16
- curved tweezers
- Unique Stitch Fabric Glue

# CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS.....

#### From **fabric**, cut:

- (3) 4" × WOF for vertical strips
- (2) 3" × WOF for horizontal strips

#### From fusible interfacing, cut:

- (1) 17" × 20" rectangle
- (1) 17" × 2" rectangle

#### From **Heat N Bond**, cut:

- (1) 17" × 20" rectangle
- (1) 17" × 2" rectangle

# Prepare Interfacing.....


Fuse Heat N Bond to fusible interfacing of the same size.

Refer to diagram (*right*). From 17"  $\times$  20" fused rectangle, cut (6) 2"  $\times$  20" strips and (3)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ "  $\times$  20" strips.

Carefully peel paper backing from all fused interfacing rectangles.

Gather the (7) 2" strips. (Six of the strips will be 20" long, one will be 17" long.)

Set the (3) 1½" strips aside until a later step.

## MAKE FABRIC STRIPS\_\_\_\_\_



**STEP 1:** Center (1) 2" interfacing strip, fusible side down, on the wrong side of (1) 4" × WOF fabric strip.



**STEP 2:** Fuse in place. Add an additional 2" interfacing strip and a partial strip to fuse interfacing to the entire length of the fabric strip.



**STEP 3:** With iron, fold fabric over fused interfacing (raw edges will meet in the middle) and press down entire length of fabric strip.



**STEP 4:** Fold strip in half lengthwise to hide raw edges. Press well.




**STEP 5:** Topstitch  $\frac{1}{8}$ " from edge along both long sides of entire length of strip.

**TIP:** Strip will be too thick to pin; we recommend using Wonder Clips to keep strip folded in half.

**STEP 6:** Repeat Steps 1-5 with remaining  $4" \times WOF$  fabric strips to make a total of (3) 1" topstitched strips. From these, cut (8) 14" strips for the basket base.


**STEP 7:** Repeat Steps 1-5, using (2)  $3" \times WOF$  fabric strips and (3)  $20" \times 1\frac{1}{2}"$  rectangles to make (2)  $\frac{3}{4}" \times WOF$  topstitched strips for horizontal basket strips. These will be cut to a custom length at a later step.




**STEP 8:** Arrange (4) 1" × 14" strips next to one another on your work surface. Arrange remaining 1" × 14" strips across their center, forming a **+** shape.



**STEP 9:** Weave strips in an alternating over-and-under pattern. Try to keep them tightly woven, but don't worry if there's a gap of 1/8" or less between the strips.



**STEP 10:** Use Wonder Clips to secure weaving for transferring to the sewing machine.



**STEP 11:** Stitch around the square at the center of the + shape.

**STEP 12:** Measure the length of the four sides of the square, and add these numbers plus ½". Our basket center measured 17". Perimeter measurement will vary depending on tightness of weave.



**STEP 13:** From the  $\frac{3}{4}$ " strips prepared in Step 7, cut (3) strips to the length calculated in Step 12. *We cut our strips to 17* $\frac{1}{2}$ ".




**STEP 14:** Overlap the raw edges by ½" and sew together with a box seam. Repeat to make a total of (3) horizontal strip rings.



**STEP 15:** Weave (1) horizontal strip ring through the ends of one side of the + shape.



**STEP 16:** Fold the edges of the + shape up 90 degrees and continue weaving the remainder of the first horizontal strip ring. Be sure to position the box seam from Step 14 on the "inside" of the basket.



**STEP 17:** Use Wonder Clips as necessary to stabilize the ring as you weave.



**STEP 18:** Weave the second horizontal strip ring through the vertical strips.



**STEP 19:** Weave the third horizontal strip ring through the vertical strips.



**STEP 20:** With the third horizontal strip ring clipped securely in place, trim the ends of each vertical strip to 13/4" from the top of the third ring.



**STEP 21:** Fold each vertical strip over the basket, alternating inside or outside the basket, and secure with Wonder Clips.



**STEP 22:** Beginning with the vertical strips that are on the outside of the basket, tuck the raw edge under the topmost horizontal ring.



**STEP 23:** Use curved tweezers to help secure these under the horizontal ring.

**STEP 24:** Once all the outside tails have been tucked, repeat the same process for the inside tails.

**STEP 25:** If desired, secure the tucked-under tails with Unique Stitch Fabric Glue.
