QUILLOW in STOMP STOMP ROAR! by modu

Quilt finishes to $40" \times 71\frac{1}{2}"$ Folds inside quillow to approx. $17\frac{1}{2}" \times 17\frac{1}{2}"$

PLEASE NOTE.....

Pay close attention to seam allowances: some are ½", some are ¼".

REQUIRED MATERIALS.....

- (4) Charm Packs OR (1) Layer Cake, cut to 5" squares OR (153) assorted 5" × 5" squares
- $\bullet\,$ 5% yard teal for pillow borders and pillow backing
- 21/8 yard blue with dinosaurs for quilt backing
- (1) $42" \times 74"$ for batting for quilt
- (1) $20" \times 20"$ for batting for pillow

CUT FABRICS.....

From **charm packs**, select:

- (144) 5" × 5" squares for patchwork quilt front
- (9) $5" \times 5"$ squares for **9-patch pillow front**

From **teal solid**, cut:

- (1) $20" \times 20"$ square for **pillow backing**
- (2) $2\frac{3}{4}$ " × $18\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles for **pillow top/bottom borders**
- (2) 2¾" × 14" rectangles for **pillow side borders**

From **batting**, cut (at least):

- (1) $42" \times 74"$ for quilt batting
- (1) $20" \times 20"$ for pillow batting

PATCHWORK PILLOW FRONT-

Arrange squares as desired in (3) rows of (3) squares each.

Sew squares into rows using a 1/4" seam allowance. Press rows in alternating directions, as indicated by arrows.

Sew rows together using a 1/4" seam allowance. Press seams up or down as desired.

Using a ¼" seam allowance, sew **pillow side border** to left and right side of pillow front. Press toward border. Sew pillow **top/ bottom border** to top and bottom of pillow front. Press toward border.

Layer **pillow batting**, **pillow backing** (right side up), and pillow front (wrong side up), with pillow front centered. <u>Pin layers together.</u>

Using a ½" seam allowance, sew around all four sides of pillow front, leaving a 4"-5" opening on one side for turning.

Trim batting and backing to be even with the patchwork pillow front. Clip corners. Remove pins. Turn right side out, pushing out corners. Fold and press seam allowance at opening, then sew opening closed. Top stitch 1/4" around all four sides.

Pillow top should measure 17½" × 17½".

Quilt as desired. Set aside.

PATCHWORK QUILT FRONT.....

Refer to Quilt Assemby diagram (right). Arrange squares as desired in (16) rows of (9) squares each.

Sew squares into rows using a 1/4" seam allowance. Press rows in alternating directions, as indicated by arrows.

Sew rows together using a 1/4" seam allowance. Press seams up or down as desired.

Stay stitch 1/4" from raw edge on all four sides.

Layer **quilt batting**, **quilt backing** (right side up), and patchwork quilt front (right side down), with quilt front centered. <u>Pin layers together</u>.

Using a ½" seam allowance, sew around all four sides of quilt front, leaving an 8"-10" opening on one side for turning.

Trim batting and backing to be even with the patchwork quilt front. Clip corners. Remove pins. Turn right side out, pushing out corners. Fold and press seam allowance at opening, then sew opening closed.

Quilt top should measure 40" × 71½". Quilt as desired.

Assemble Quillow_____

Refer to Quillow Assembly diagram (below). Place quilt on work surface, backing side up. Place pillow front on quilt, backing side up, centered with bottom edges aligned. Pin in place.

Using a generous ¼" seam allowance, stitch around sides and bottom of pillow top, backstitching to secure at the top edges. Because this seam will have repeated stress when the quilt is folded into the pillow, we recommend sewing this seam a second time.




Quillow Assembly

Folding the Quillow.....



STEP 1: Fold sides of quilt toward the front along the seams of the pillow.

STEP 2: Turn pillow right side out over quilt, as if you were folding the cuff on a pair of socks.

STEP 3: Fold the top of the quilt down to meet the top of the pillow.

STEP 4: Tuck the folded quilt inside the pillow.
