

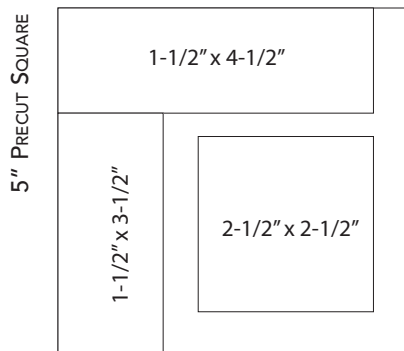

A	 CPSELLI-X	5" Square Pack CPSELLI-X	3 Packs	NOTE: Each 5" square yields (3) cut pieces; subcut (100) 2-1/2" squares, (100) 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" and (100) 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles. REFER TO DIAGRAM BELOW.
B		53789-5 Cream	1/2	(8) 1-1/2" x WOF strips; subcut (50) 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" and (50) 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles.
C		53790-4 Moss	3/4	Border: (6) 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Piece strips and subcut (2) 3-1/2" x 63" and (2) 3-1/2" x 57" borders.
D		53791-6 Dark Brown FOR BINDING	5/8	Binding: Cut into (7) 2-1/4" strips.
E		53793-9 Linen	1/2	(8) 1-1/2" x WOF strips; subcut (50) 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" and (50) 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles.
F		53794-5 Cream	1-3/8	(9) 4-1/2" x WOF strips; subcut (81) 4-1/2" squares.
G		53795-9 Linen	1/2	(2) 7" x WOF strips; subcut Setting Triangles: (9) 7" squares. Cut each on the diagonal twice for a total of (36) setting triangles. Corner Triangles: (2) 4" squares. Cut each on the diagonal once for a total of (4) corner triangles.
		Backing	4	70-1/2" x 70-1/2" piece of batting.



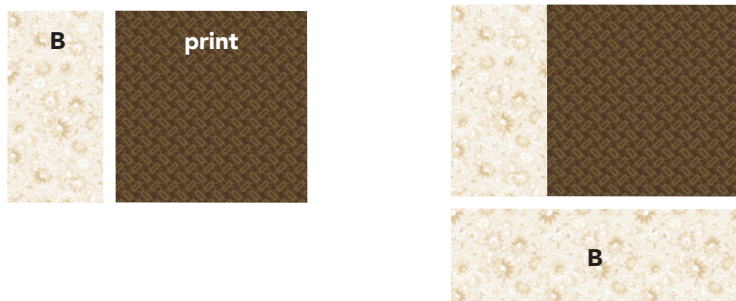


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PIECED BLOCK

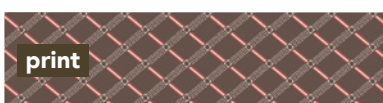
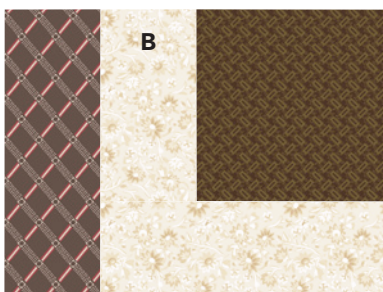
REFERENCE QUILT IMAGE FOR FABRIC PLACEMENT.

- Block 1: Sew (1) **B** 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangle to the left side of (1) **print** 2-1/2" square. Then, sew (1) **B** 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangle to the bottom of the block.



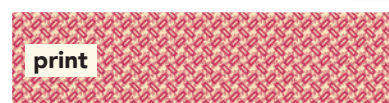
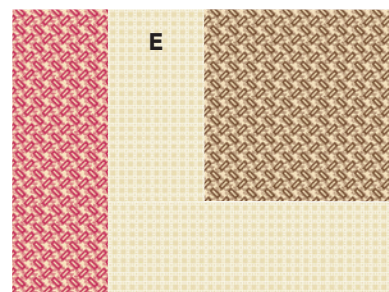
- Sew (1) **print** 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangle to the left side of the **Step 1** block. Finish by adding (1) 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" of the same **print** rectangle to the bottom of the block. Make (50) total of Block 1.
- Block 2: Repeat Step 1-2 using **E** cream fabric, as shown.

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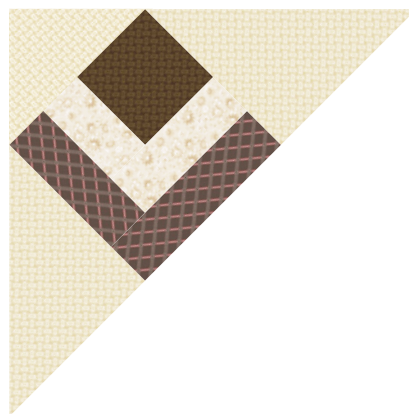
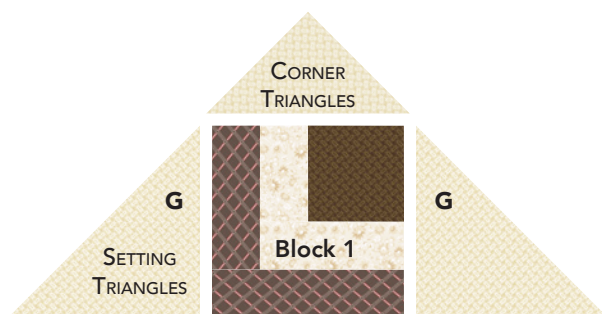

QUILT CENTER ASSEMBLY

4. Pieced Diagonal Rows

Arrange and sew pieced Blocks 1 and 2, **F** 4-1/2" squares, **G** setting triangles (SR) and **G** corner triangles (CT) into rows, starting from left to right. Row 1 is shown.

Row 1: **G** SR - Block 1 - **G** SR - **G** CT



5. Sew pieced diagonal rows to complete quilt center. Trim quilt center to 1/4" beyond the seam intersections on outside edges of quilt center to approximately 57" square.
6. Border: Sew (2) **C** 3-1/2" x 57" strips to the opposite sides of the quilt center, followed by (2) **C** 3-1/2" x 63" strips to the remaining opposite sides of quilt center to complete the quilt top.



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QUILT ASSEMBLY



FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich.
Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **D** 2-1/4" strips.
