

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# FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

- 1 yard black
- 1 yard red

## **Recommended Products**

- Shabby Fabrics Rectangle Ruler 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" × 6<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>"
- Schmetz Topstitch Needles, size 80/12
- Clover Point 2 Point Turner
- Clover Patchwork Pins (Extra Fine) All available at Shabby Fabrics.com

### NAPKINS\_

### From **black** fabric, cut:


• (4) 18" × 18" squares

#### From **red** fabric, cut:

• (4) 18" × 18" squares

Place (1) black square on top of (1) red square, right sides together, and sew around all four edges with a ¼" seam allowance, leaving a 5" opening for turning. Clip corners and turn right side out. Press, being sure to fold raw edges of opening inward ¼". Topstitch ¼" around entire napkin. Press.

Repeat to make a total of (4) napkins.
